Reform in practice: Preparation for adulthood – what have we learnt so far?

- Support needs to start early thinking about:
- Pathways to employment including exploring different employment options, such as support for becoming self-employed and help from supported employment agencies;
 - —Independent living enabling people to have choice and control over their lives and the support they receive and their accommodation and living arrangements, including supported living;
 - -Participating in society including having friends and supportive relationships, and participating in, and contributing to, the local community; and
 - -Being as **healthy** as possible in adult life.









Local offer

 All areas have a local offer and some good examples for preparing for adulthood emerging.

EHCP's – the golden thread









- Shared understanding of developing outcomes for young people
- Greater understanding of the evidence base for PfA outcomes – Employment, Health, Independent Living, Friends relationships and community
- Peer review of EHCP's in some regions
- Exemplars to come out of demonstration sites








Engagement of young people

- Better evidence of young people contributing to their plans
- Young people starting to be involved more strategically
- Development of young commissioners and young inspectors to support reforms
- Planning for Life









Integrated working and joint commissioning

- LAs, colleges and other providers engaged on a joint 'preparing for adulthood' plan as part of implementing reforms
- LA's working towards a 0-25 Integrated Service across Education, Health and Care
- Trying to join up the dots between IPC, Transforming Care and 0-25 reforms







Still a long way to go.....

- Personal budgets especially education and health
- Keeping inclusion on the agenda numbers in mainstream schools are decreasing and the numbers of young people excluded with SEN increasing
- Joining the dots across government programmes – IPC, Transforming Care etc.
- Influx of interim posts
- Austerity and funding!!!
