Residents' priorities

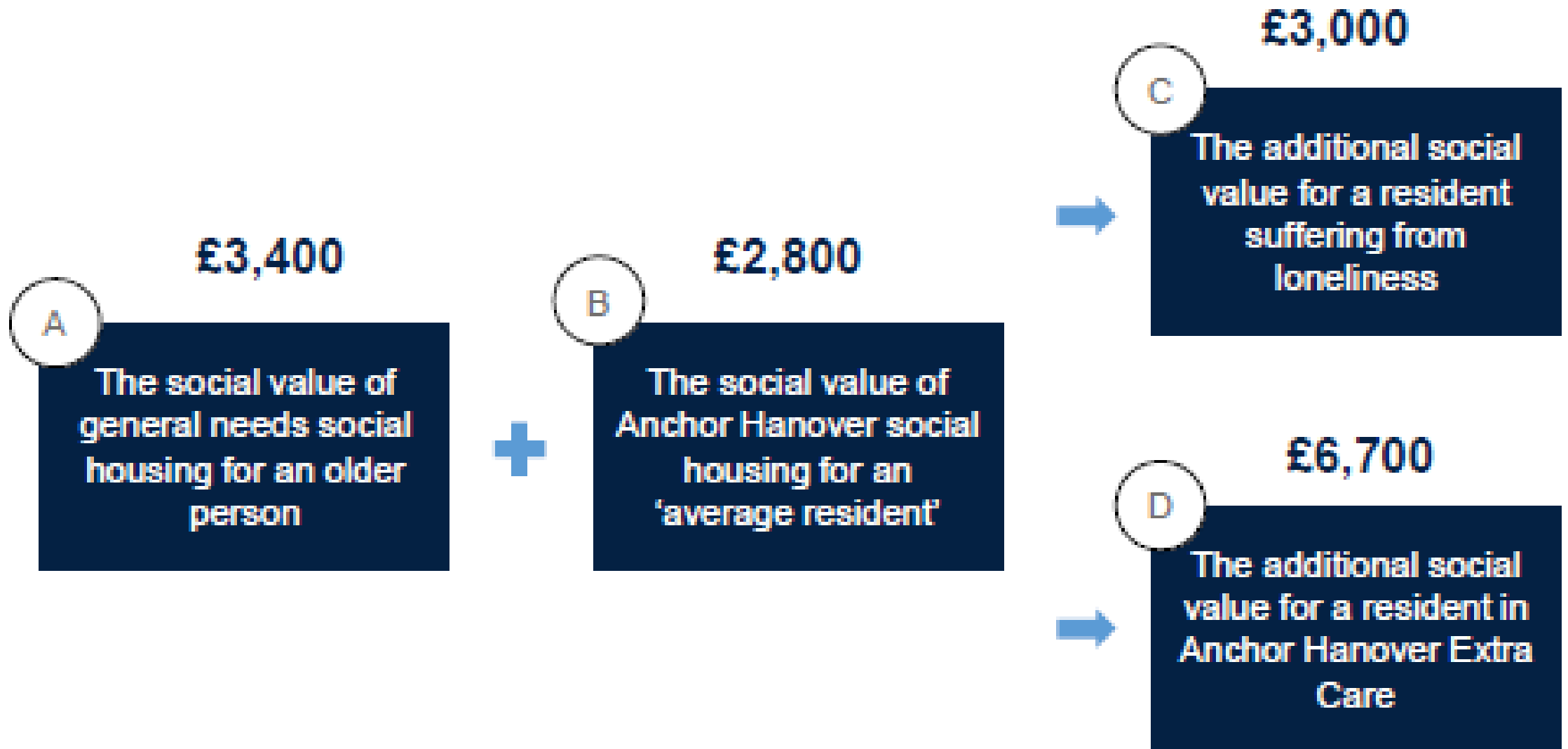
- Tackling loneliness (58%)

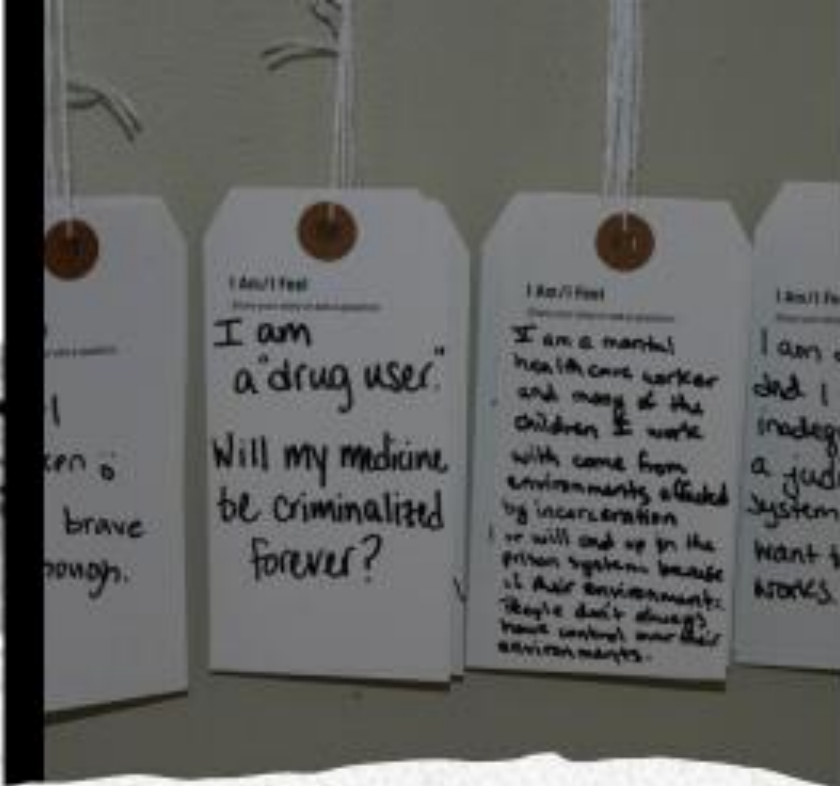
